### Membership of the Special Schools Sports Partnership

- To allow pupils to safely attend challenging events
- Pupils with challenging behaviour, communication needs and medical needs were effectively supported to participate by familiar staff.

- Pupils experienced speed, exercise and accessed adapted cycles allowing them maximum independent movement.
