Maths	Measuring – Measure the heights of everyone in your house. Who is the tallest and who is the shortest? Can you put the heights of everyone in order from shortest to tallest? Can you now measure the weights of everyone? Who is heaviest and who is the lightest?	Can you throw a ball into a basket? If it's easy you might need to take a few steps back. Record how many times you get it in. Can you beat your score next time?
