Art/science	 We are going to use a fish to make some prints. This is an old Japanese art technique called gyotaku. Thin down some paint with water and PVA glue and paint one side of the fish. Lay the fish on a piece of paper and lightly press all over so the whole of the fish makes contact. Carefully remove the fish – you should be able to see the scales and fins in the print. 	Exploring musical instruments. Do you have any instruments at home you could play or make your own band with your family. Physical	Put on your favourite music and enjoy moving and dancing along to it.	Together go a for a walk and listen to the nature around you. What can you hear? Birds singing, leaves rustling in the wind, dogs barking.
Maths	Patterns- can you find any items around your house or in your garden that has a pattern e.g wallpaper, a stripy t-shirt, bricks on your house.	If you have some threading beads you could have a go at the attached sheets to see if you could copy the pattern. Then have a go at cutting out the coloured circles and making your own repeating patterns.
