Art/science	<p>Swishy Bags or Sensory Bag You will need 1 cup of flour, 6 tablespoons of water and food colouring. You will also need zip-lock lunch bags, sticky tape and a small mixing bowl.</p> <p>Place flour into a small bowl, add food colouring and then the water. Spoon into the zip lock lunch bag and fasten. Add sticky tape to ensure there are no holes.</p> <p>Use your finger, soft paint brush to write your name, numbers, shapes, patterns.</p> <p>Alternative, you can use blue coloured water (to look like the sea) and mix with oil and add small plastic fish.</p>	<p>Science Experiment Have a go at the colour changing water experiment</p> <p>You will need 3 glass cups, paper towels, food colouring and water. http://coolscienceexperimentshq.com/color-changing-walking-water/</p>
