The Local Authority has issued guidance on the provision of transport and I felt you may find it helpful to have sight of this.

They note that they do expect potential disruption to transport, should transport staff need to self isolate, and that they will liaise with you about this, not school. Should a particular transport route be cancelled then this absence would be authorised by school.

## \*\*\* Important \*\*\* - COVID19 Update including new requirements for self-isolation

Yesterday evening, the Prime Minister announced stricter measures for dealing with the Coronavirus crisis. These measures start immediately:

Anyone with a high temperature or a persistent cough, or anyone in the same household with them, is to stay at home for 14 days. This means that siblings will now need to be off school together. This will also apply to siblings of pupils who have been off yesterday.

In addition, schools have been instructed to send home anyone with a cough and/or temperature, and to **suspect** that it is Coronavirus.
