This year, we will be celebrating World Book Day next **Thursday 4th March**.

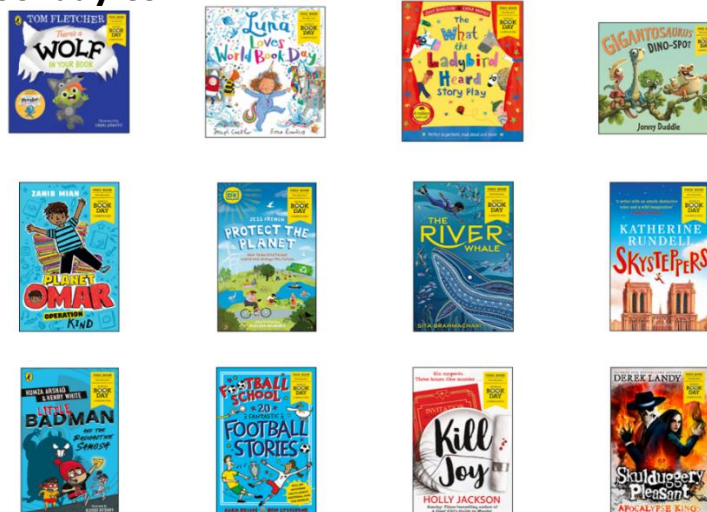
Although we will be celebrating a little differently this year, remaining in our class bubbles, the day will still be an excellent chance for students to enjoy books and reading!
