


# Training Summary Autumn term 2019






# Equalities Pupil Profile & SEN Needs






#### SEN Needs Autumn 2019






# No of Looked after children & Pupil Premium







Numbers of pupils with specific plans and / or Multi Disciplinary Team involvement





# Speech & Language Therapy Caseload

#### Staffing:

Wendy (Band 7) - 3.75 hours per week & additionally dysphagia, AAC support and Makaton training support. Also supervision for other team members.

Sarah Marshall (Band 6) – 3.75 hours per week.

Megan Critchlow (Band 5) - 13.5 hours per week (maternity cover for Annabelle - July 2020)

Rowena Fellingham (Band 8) – covering PL in secondary for two terms.

Slightly in excess of 21 hours SaLT per week (increase from historical 13 hours thanks to Out of Area income and the Service Level Agreement from the Year 7 Top Up Fund)

Students on SaLT caseload (under 18) = 53. Capacity for SaLT = 45 students, over capacity by 8.


#### Highlights:

- Termly meetings with SaLTs, Andrew Sudron and SLCN reps (Sandra Lai, Emma Gibson and Holly Eldridge) with a project plan for school development of communication support.
- · Given the increased numbers on caseload (over capacity), there is a real need for ring-fenced time from school for SLCN reps (as at The Forest School where there is 1 WTE ATA in place). Can some time be put forward?
- · Makaton training given to Caitlyn Hughes and Jack Muphy-King October 2019. Next Makaton training session likely to be in Spring Term (Springwater staff can be booked onto this course Wendy will negotiate a reduction in cost for multiple bookings).
- Termly multidisciplinary feeding clinic.















# Pupil Tracking for Attendance
