Then and Now : cooking

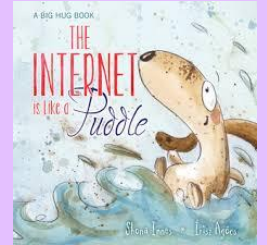
Can you try making some Angel delight with a hand whisk and then try with an electric whisk? Which is easier?
