Have you got a play tent or a pop up tunnel or maybe you could use a table with blankets over it.

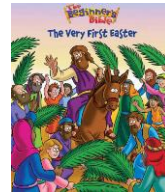
- Can the children move in and out of the tents and tunnels?

Watch and think about the Easter Story.

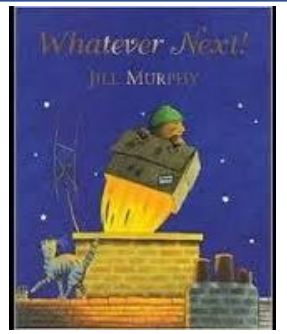
